## **2017 Hub DeJong Baseball Tourney Policies**

### **Payment**

- \$300 nonrefundable payment is required on sign up date
- The first 6 or 8 teams in each division to pay will secure their spot in the tournament.
- A waiting list will be kept for each tournament division. Teams on the waiting list will be contacted in the order that their calls were received. When we contact a coach from the waiting list, coaches will be given 24 hours to reply before we move onto the next name or team.
- No cancellations allowed and no refunds will be given once paid.

### **Inclement Weather Policy**

- In the event of rain we will do everything in our power to make games stay as close to the original game schedule as possible. If we do have to alter the game schedule our first priority is the safety of each individual at the facility. We will handle the inclement weather as it arises. Games will need to have completed 2 ½ or 3 innings (if the home team is behind) to be a complete game.
- If the weather for the whole weekend is unplayable we will refund \$200 to each team.

### **General Information**

- Tournament Dates: June 2<sup>nd</sup>-June 4<sup>th</sup>.
- The athletic staff will contact coaches with further information after teams have registered.
- Coaches must submit full team rosters prior to first pitch.
- Teams are guaranteed 4 games.
- Absolutely no alcohol, tobacco or pets are allowed on the premises.
- The Boys & Girls Club will provide umpires for each game.
- We will provide game balls for each game.
- There will be no gate fee, all the events are free.
- Players will wear their spring baseball jersey during the tournament games. This includes players picked up from another team. The additional players are not required to match the rest of the team.
- Tournament shirts will be available to purchase at the concession stand.
- Home run derby on Sunday for rec division: coaches register 3 players Friday or Saturday for their chance to win great prizes!
- Teams can have a maximum of 14 players on their roster that played spring Boys & Girls Club baseball. A maximum of four players can be from another team that played minor A/B or major A/B leagues during the 2017 spring league. Minors may play up in the major division but majors may not play down. Select players are NOT eligible to play on a rec tournament team. Rec Players may be picked up on a Select team.
